

Brigham Young University–Idaho

Brigham Young University-Idaho (BYU–Idaho) is a private university located in Rexburg, Idaho, and is affiliated with The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS Church). It offers a wide range of undergraduate programs across disciplines such as business, education, the sciences, and the arts. BYU-Idaho enrolls approximately 30,000 on-campus students and 28,500 online students worldwide, half of whom are located outside the United States. The online programs, offered in partnership with BYU-Pathway Worldwide, offer 30 online certificates and several bachelor's degrees in fields such as business, technology, health, family studies, and professional studies.



College-in-3 Program: The [Accelerated Bachelor degree program](#) consists of 3 “stackable” certificates, General Education, and other required courses for a total of 90-96 credits. The program has no free electives. No minors are required. All other bachelor degree requirements remain the same. The accelerated degree options are available in the following disciplines: Applied Business Management, Applied Health, Communication, Family and Human Services, Information Technology, Professional Studies, and Software Development.
